

## License, permit and miscellaneous bonds

License and permit bonds are required by state law, municipal ordinance, regulation and, in some instances, the federal government or its agencies as a condition for granting a license to engage in a business or a permit to exercise a privilege. The bond provides indemnification for loss or damage resulting from the license or permit holder's failure to comply with a law, ordinance or regulation.

Some examples of license and permit bonds include:

- Bonds required by Packers and Stockyards Act (market agencies or dealers and packers)
- Commission merchants and produce dealers bond
- Livestock dealers bond
- Milk dealer bond
- Contractor license bond
- Excess weight and other highway and street permit bonds
- Carnet bond
- Customs bond
- Collection agency bond
- Insurance adjuster, agent, broker and surplus lines agent and broker bond
- Mortgage broker, banker and lender bond
- Real-estate agent and broker bond
- Third-party administrator bond
- Title insurance company agent and escrow officer bond
- Motor vehicle dealer bond
- Employment agency bond
- Transportation broker bond
- Travel agency bond

- Alcohol, alcoholic beverages and liquor tax bond
- Cigar, cigarette and tobacco tax bond
- Sales, use and consumer tax bond
- Warehouse bond

Miscellaneous surety bonds cover a wide variety of bonds that are unique in purpose. While some are required by law, most are purely voluntary bonds arising out of contractual obligations negotiated between private parties.
