How does it work?

Zurich's Cyber Risk Assessment process includes the following steps:

1. Hold an initial discussion to establish objectives, scope, participants, timing and deliverables.
2. Interview the security leader and their team members. Generally, these are conducted over the phone, but may be in person.
3. Review the draft report and recommendations with security lead.
4. Provide the final presentation of report and prioritized recommendations to management.

Whether you are new to cyber security with an interest in building a strategy and creating management awareness, or you are an organization with extensive cyber knowledge requiring an objective perspective on your cyber defenses, a cyber risk assessment will reveal the status and maturity of your cyber security defenses. It will also indicate those areas where improvements will be most impactful.
